

Cowtown Day 2018 Eagle's Golden Egg Hunt

Wednesday, August 22nd

9 a.m. – Darkness – the egg was hidden inside of the pipe frame of a bleacher

2 p.m. – Leads in and out – K-14 leads into and out of town and the rodeo is close to the highway

Thursday, August 23rd

9 a.m. – Out of 997 - # of reported Ellsworth, KS households in the 2010 census and the egg was hidden outside of the city limits

2 p.m. – Don't cross the fences – the arena and the ball fields have several fenced off areas and the egg was hidden outside of all the fenced off areas

Friday, August 24th

9 a.m. – A border is close – Egg hidden just outside of the Ellsworth City Limits

2 p.m. – 37 – Number of red barrels at the arena

Saturday, August 25th

9 a.m. – Art in metal – Referring to the metal art on the arena gates

2 p.m. – Tame and unbroken – Referring to the animals in the arena, some are tame some have not been broken.

Sunday, August 26th

9 a.m. – White stakes – Many white posts hold up the fence at the arena

2 p.m. – Amongst the seven – Seven sets of bleachers on the side the egg was hidden

Monday, August 27th

9 a.m. – Rails of Blue – Steps over the egg hiding spot are blue

2 p.m. – Sports all around – Rodeo arena on one side of the road, and ball diamonds on the other

Tuesday, August 28th

9 a.m. – EL-KAN – Name of the rodeo arena

2 p.m. – 108 between two white – the fence in front of the egg location has 108 rectangle shapes between two white posts
